



Arizona FCCLA Membership Pricing Guide

A minimum of 12 students plus one (1) adviser must be registered in the national affiliation system. Students must be currently or previously enrolled in a Family and Consumer Sciences program. Memberships are valid from the date the national office receives and applies payment to the invoice through July 31 of that school year.

Individual Membership

The cost to join Arizona FCCLA is \$20 per student and adviser. Chapters may add additional students or advisers to their original roster at any time after the initial registration at the normal rate of \$20 per person.

Middle School Unlimited

The cost for this package is \$400 (\$250 National Dues / \$150 State Dues) and includes: unlimited student affiliations and adviser membership.

Unlimited Membership Package

The cost for this package is \$1,825 (\$775 National Dues / \$1050 State Dues) and includes: unlimited student affiliations in one (1) chapter, unlimited adviser affiliations in one chapter, one (1) Adviser Academy registration, one (1) National Program of choice, and one (1) Lifetime Alumni & Associates membership for anyone of choice, and an annual FCCLA Knowledge Hub subscription. This package is ideal for total program affiliation.

Up to 25 Membership Package

The cost for this package is \$670 (\$395 National Dues / \$275 State Dues) and includes: one (1) adviser, up to 25 students, one (1) Adviser Academy registration, one (1) National Program of choice, one (1) Lifetime Alumni & Associates membership for anyone of choice, and an annual FCCLA Knowledge Hub subscription. Each student exceeding 25 members will be charged at the individual membership rate of \$20.
