Competitive Events Updates



In General

- Students must be affiliated (paid) members by January 25, 2026, to compete at SLC
- Levels are based on grades
 - Level 1: 5-8
 - Level 2: 9 & 10
 - Level 3: 11 & 12
 - Level 4: Postsecondary
- Members may participate in up to one (1) STAR Event and one (1) Proficiency Event
- Some events have level eligibilities







- Students Taking Action with Recognition
- National events compete at SLC to qualify for NLC
 - Top two (2) per level per STAR Event scoring an 80 or higher*
 - TOP THREE (3) in the following events
 - NEW THIS YEAR
 - Career Investigation
 - Focus on Children
 - Job Interview
 - Leadership
 - Say Yes to FCS
 - Sustainability Challenge
 - Teach or Train



- Up to three (3) entries per level per chapter
 - Exception: Baking & Pastry and Culinary Arts are limited to two (2) entries per chapter
- Arizona has a different menu for Baking & Pastry and Culinary Arts: refer to <u>azfccla.org/star-events</u>
 - Menus and recipes are posted on the STAR Events page of the AZ website
- Any affiliated member can compete in any STAR Event



- Events are either Individual or Team events
- A team may consistent of one (1), two (2), or three (3) members; exception is Parliamentary Procedure with up to eight (8)
 - Defined in each event description refer to guidelines
- Mixed teams compete at highest-level team member
- Online STAR Events recognized at SLC and NLC



- Online STAR Events recognized at SLC and NLC
 - Registration and submission deadline February 1, 2026
 - Pre-submitted NOT performed at SLC
 - Finalists (20) qualify to compete at NLC
 - Step by Step Registration instructions on National site

- Two (2) per chapter per event per level
 - Hands-on culinary events limited to two (2) per chapter
 - Mystery Basket limited to one (1) per chapter

 - Additional Fee
- Do not need to qualify at SLC to compete at NLC; but space is limited and fills up quickly on a first-come first-served basis
